Mervyn Sharp was a former King of the Channel® with seven crossings of the English Channel, done between 1967 and 1974. His crossings included: 18 hours and 34 minutes crossing in 1967 from France to England and 6 crossings from England to France in 1968 (17 hours and 52 minutes), 1969 (14 hours and 29 minutes and 19 hours and 41 minutes), 1970 (15 hours and 14 minutes), 1973 (15 hours and 17 minutes) and 1974 (13 hours and 42 minutes).

He swam 16 km from Lulworth Cove to Weymouth; 32 km 2-way) between Weymouth and Lulworth Cove; 12.8 km between Torquay and Brixham; 12.8 km Lake Bala in Wales; 48.2 km from Swanage to Weymouth; 14.4 km from Swanage to Bournemouth; and 25 km at the 1970 Lake Windermere Championships in England.

He competed in professional marathon swims in Canada in 1971 and 1972 including the 34 km Lac St-Jean; 37 km Saguenay and 24-hour La Tuque Relay.
