

Martha Norelius, Honor Swimmer, United States of America, 1984

Martha Norelius won 1 Major: 1929 Canadian National Exhibition. She won US\$10,000 in his 16.1 km race in Toronto which was witnessed by 100,000 spectators and most of the 45 starters withdrew due to cold and eel bites.

Martha was a top pool swimmer who turned to professional marathon swimming after she was suspended from amateur competition in 1929 for giving an exhibition in the same pool with professional swimmers. She won a gold medal in the 400-meter freestyle at the 1924 Olympics and two gold medals in the 1928 Olympics.

She is also an inductee in the International Swimming Hall of Fame (1967).
