Rottnest Channel Swim Association has conducted solo and relay crossings of the 19.7 km Rottnest Channel since 1989. The Association priorities are to: observe and authenticate swims across the Rottnest Channel; promote safety; advise and encourage swimmers wanting to make an attempt; and gather and preserve historical data from the crossings.

The Rottnest Channel Swim Association have authenticated solo and relay swimmers since 1956, more than 25,000 individuals to 2024 (and beyond).
