Beth Yudovin enjoyed two careers in the sport. For the first 25+ years she served as her husband's (David Yudovin Honor Swimmer in IMSHOF and ISHOF) manager and crew chief. Together they completed first ever marathon swims in Azores; California's Channel Islands; Indonesia; Japan; México; New Zealand; Portugal; and in Africa: Cape Verde plus São Tomé and Príncipe. They also completed marathon swims in Tahiti, Hawaii, English Channel and Strait of Gibraltar.

Beth's second career involved serving on IMSHOF's Executive Committee from 2014 to 2022 (and beyond). She chaired the Committee, hosted two Induction and Awards Ceremonies and managed the finances.

She received The Dale Petranech Award for Services to the International Marathon Swimming Hall of Fame in 2020.
