



Carol Sing, Honor Swimmer, United States of America, 2000

Carol Sing became the oldest woman in history in 1997, at age 55, to swim the Catalina Channel when she crossed in 10 hours 38 minutes in 1997 – the record held until 2010. She became the oldest female to cross the English Channel at age 57.9 in 1999 – the record held until 2006. She completed the 45.9 km Around Manhattan Island swim in 8 hours and 46 minutes in 1998 and in 9 hours and 16 minutes in 2001 – both female records for the oldest at 56 and 59 – which held until 2018. The Triple Crown was achieved with an English Channel crossing in 1999 in 12 hours and 32 minutes. Carol completed Coronado Around the Island 17.7 km 3 times; Strait of Gibraltar; and Maui Channel. She served as a Catalina Channel Swimming Federation committee member from 2002 to 2022.

Carol received the Dale Petranec Award for Service to the International Marathon Swimming Hall of Fame in 2025.
