**Peter Jurzynski** started his marathon career in 1980 with IMSHOF Honoree James Doty in the 8-mile Boston Light Swim. His career revolved around the English Channel with fourteen success in twenty attempts. Peter's first success came in 1987 in a time of 12 hours and 7 minutes. This was his fastest English Channel time. He was a model of consistency for two periods. Five annual successes from 1996 to 2000 and six annual success from 2002 to 2007. Peter's goal, during his career, was a crossing each year for as long as possible.
